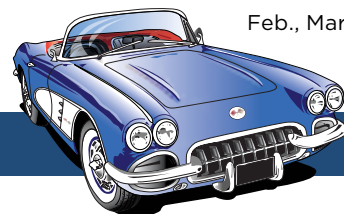

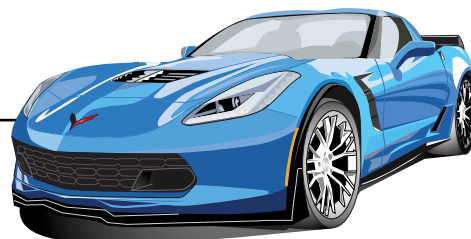

ISSUE WITH ANTI-LOCK BRAKES ON C5 CORVETTE

My Corvette C5 coupe developed a problem which caused the anti-lock brakes, the traction control and the active handling codes to flash on every time I started the car. At first it happened occasionally, but the problem eventually caused the codes to come on all the time. As if that wasn't bad enough, the ABS light and the traction control indicator on the instrument panel remained lit while the car was running. I checked with the local Chevy dealers, and only one had an idea of what the problem was. I was told the fix could cost around \$1,400.00. They instructed me to remove the ABS control module from the car and send it to them in Georgia. The module is located behind the left head light, and once the car was on the lift, it came out fairly easily, and the car can be driven. At a number of car shows, I ran into other people reporting the same problem with their own C5 Corvettes, and some told me of a company in Duluth, Georgia, that was able to fix the problem, with the issue never reoccurring. I contacted the company for more information.

They instructed me to remove the ABS control module from the car and send it to them in Georgia. The module is located behind the left head light, and once the car was on the lift, it came out fairly easily, and the car can be driven with the part removed. The unit came back to me from Georgia in a few days. The whole fix, including shipping, cost me less than \$200, and the problem has been resolved.

The company is My Air Bags in Duluth, Georgia. Their phone number is 678-778-8890. They also perform similar repairs for other model cars, in addition to Corvettes. I found it interesting that most repair shops had no idea of what was causing this problem, especially with the C5 Corvette, where this appears to be a common issue. I found Huntington Chevrolet to be the only local dealership on the right track.
